Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle Funding



Accessibility refers to the design of environments, products, devices, or services that makes it possible for people to approach, enter, or use them.

Transportation in a non-accessible vehicle can not only be challenging, it can be dangerous for individuals who use a wheelchair for mobility. It is much safer to travel and transition in and out of an accessible van.

There are many different wheelchair accessible vehicle options to choose from. Research the different options online, attend conferences or resource fairs and talk to other families. Dealerships that specialize in wheelchair accessible vehicles are a great resource. They can show you different options and may offer an option to rent, to allow you to try before you buy.

One important thing to keep in mind when looking for funding options is the type of wheelchair your child uses. Many funders do not offer assistance if a portable wheelchair, one that can be folded and placed in a trunk is used.
